

## Path Volunteer Trip Report June, 2012

Many thanks go out to Marcia, Steve and Diana for their work in going in to Summerfest. I also want to give a special thanks to Sam Mabe for the time and effort he put into cutting the camp sites and viewing area for PATH. Thanks to all of you!

We had beautiful weather and cool windy evenings. We had 29 volunteers on Saturday to work and numerous individuals in camp to do the hike with Diana. We had a total of 41 people in camp on Saturday either hiking or going out to work.

Wednesday - Saturday Work completed by Volunteers:

1. Stream crossing S of Settlers checked for safety, Beaver Dam II repairs checked, Trail walked from Settlers Museum to US-11
2. Beaver Dam I checked for safety, looked at repairs made last month and future solutions to erosion problems
3. High water trail painted with Blue Blazes from 610 (Tilson) to US-42 (Olystery). 2 miles
4. Davis Farm assesment made as to what to replace on Tent pad. 4 locust logs on West side and cut view out. Locust on site. Info given to Sylvia and Mark.
5. Scouting for possible trail relo as enter Laurel Fork Wilderness from 623. 20%-30%
- 6 Preliminary scouting done for work at Knot Maul steps, privy and drainage at Lynn Camp Creek and work to be done on bridge mildew/slippery. Tools needed.
7. Will scouted out tree of Heaven sittings on PATH sections.

Work Completed on Saturday:

1. Trail lopped from 222-US-42, 2 stream crossings need replacement/mud holes for drainage need cleaning out/side hill work at Lynn Camp Mt. and bog areas need work. 100' section 1/2 mile in needs extensive work.

Bottom Limbs need to be cut off of tree N of Lick Creek bridge.

2..Two crews sent in to Knot Maul. Rock above cribbing on steps moved from above cribbing to below to support collapsing cribbing. Rock also placed below cribbing on steps. Trail lopped, Privy moved from one side to other side, privy material dispersed, Knot Maul Creek bridge walking surface painted and sand applied to improve traction on crossing in wet weather. Drainage Ditches and rock water bars installed in wet area near Lynn Camp Bridge.
