




Chatfield Privy has been broken into again. I got measurements for Jim H of the door, so a new plan to close it up can happen.


Loved the steps South of Chatfield! Thanks Jerry, Josh, Brian, Rachel and the rest of the Konnarock Crew.





Comments & Observations	Had a thru hiker pass me in the parking lot. He took a wrong turn at the Creeper/Accessible Fishing Trail Junction. Walked him back to the trail. Some grass, foliage blocked the signs. And since the 2 trails parallel, if you are looking a Guthooks, you think you are on the trail, until you hit the parking lot. Trail to Saunders was in great shape. No obstructions. Alerted hikers to possible confusion at the trail junction and to stay left. Removed trash from the bear box. Left over Mac and cheese. Checked the Privy. Lots of beautiful wild flowers South of Saunders on the switch backs.
	Sign at the junction of the Creeper and AT Spur has been destroyed. Spoke with a couple who live in Taylor's Valley. They appreciate the port a John's being back. Had folks using the bathroom in the yard last year. They would like more of the trash removed from the trail.

Added a couple blue blazes, cut some small trees to make white blazes more visible, and freshened a few white blazes at the junction where the hiker had come off trail on Sunday. 	Held court at Lost Mountain Shelter and discussed LNT practices and how the wonderful bear boxes would soon end and hanging food would become a nightly thing again. More garbage in the bear box. Removed			
	Was notified by Frankenfoot of a hiker named Sparrow that allegedly threatened some hikers at Trail Days. Was able to quickly locate Sparrow, get a photo and notify Kathryn and Brian Wilson. Have since learned thanks to Mr Rainey, that the Damascus Police interviewed him and deemed him a Non threat to himself and others.




Blowdown(s) - # 2
